9. Highways List

No new items had been added to the highways list prior to the meeting but a members raised the following points;

- The drain in Gainsborough Street outside the Christopher Centre was still flooding every time there was heavy rain. Although this had been reported on the Suffolk Highways online reporting tool (ref 466708), it had been closed as ‘added to inspection programme’. This was not acceptable and the Town Clerk was asked to raise this with the Suffolk County Council member (Cllr J Carter) and Suffolk Highways officers.
- A large plant was growing out of the kerb on Northern Road. This had been growing for over a year as it could be seen on the Google street view picture taken in June 2023. The Town Clerk reported this on the Suffolk Highways online reporting tool (ref 469514).
