HIGHWAYS

10. TO DISCUSS THE HIGHWAYS LIST

No new items had been added to the highways list prior to the meeting but members raised the following points;

- The drain on Waldingfield Road, opposite number 90, was blocked with silt and now long grass
 was growing out of it. This caused significant flooding when there was heavy rain as the water
 flowed further downhill. The Town Clerk reported this on the Suffolk Highways reporting tools
 as reference 481386.
- The hedge on the east side of Ballingdon Hill was growing out into the highway from the
 industrial estate up to the entrance into Ballingdon Hall. This had made it unsafe to walk
 along the path as pedestrians were forced out into the traffic. The Town Clerk reported this
 on the Suffolk Highways reporting tools as reference 481387.

Members remained concerned over the lack of action by Suffolk Highways to clear the drain on Gainsborough Street outside the Christopher Centre. Cllr J Carter, in her role as a County Councillor, offered to circulate the reports on this problem from Suffolk Highways.
